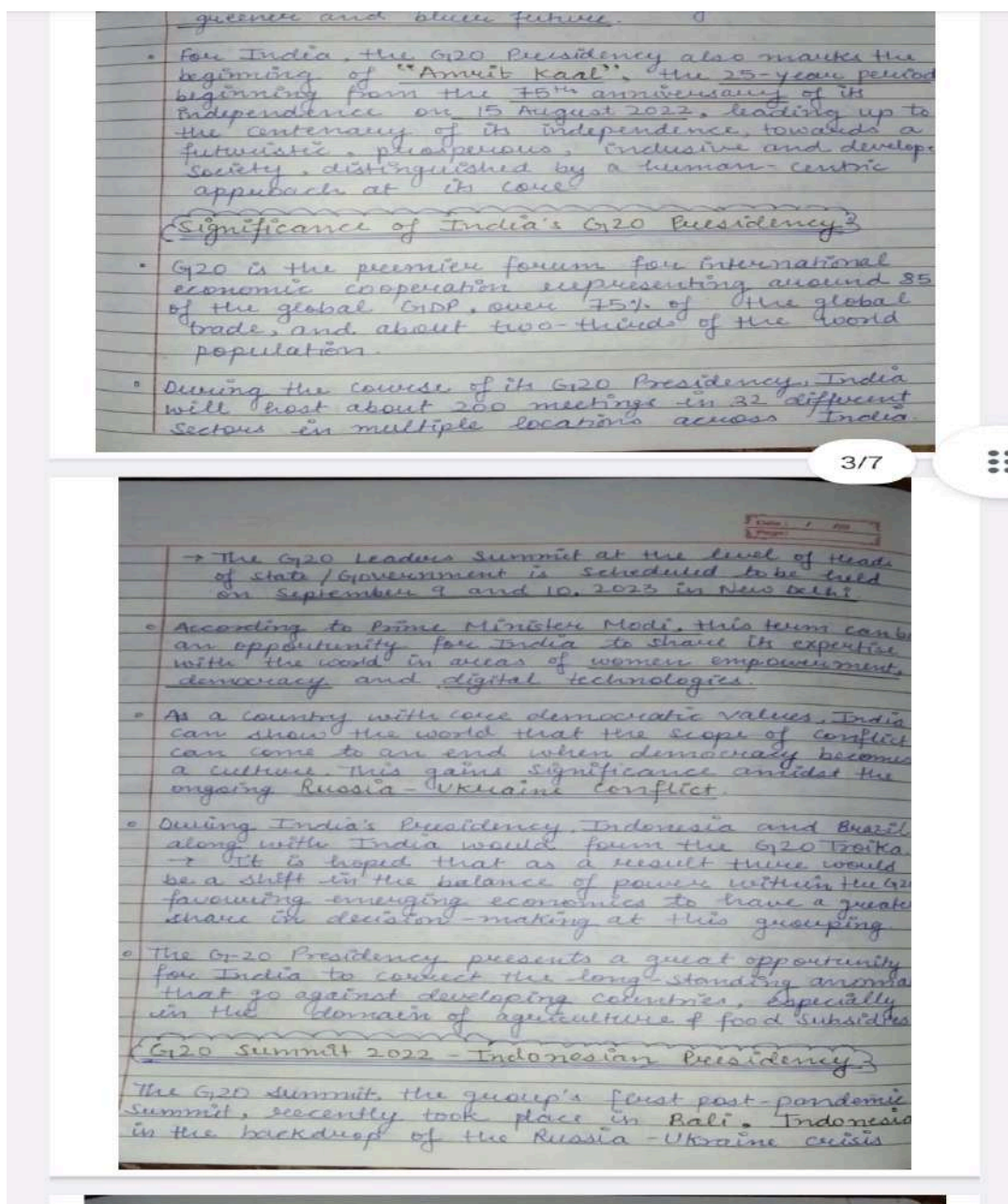


Essay Writing Competition

India assumed the presidency of the G20 grouping from Indonesia, on December 1, 2023, and will hold the post for a year. This offers a unique opportunity for India to contribute to the global agenda on pressing issues of international importance.

Recently G20 summits started focusing not only on macro economy and trade; but also on a wide range of global issues which have an immense impact on the global economy since globalization started progressing and various issues became more intricately intertwined. These issues included overall development, climate change and energy, health, counter-terrorism, as well as migration and refugees.

The G20 has sought to realize an inclusive and sustainable world through its contributions towards resolving these global issues.

G20 India Presidency

India's G20 logo juxtaposes planet Earth with the lotus, India's national flower and the theme is "Vaardhaiva Kutumbakam" or "One Earth - One Family - One Future". The G20 logo draws inspiration from the vibrant colours of India's national flag - saffron, white and green, and blue.

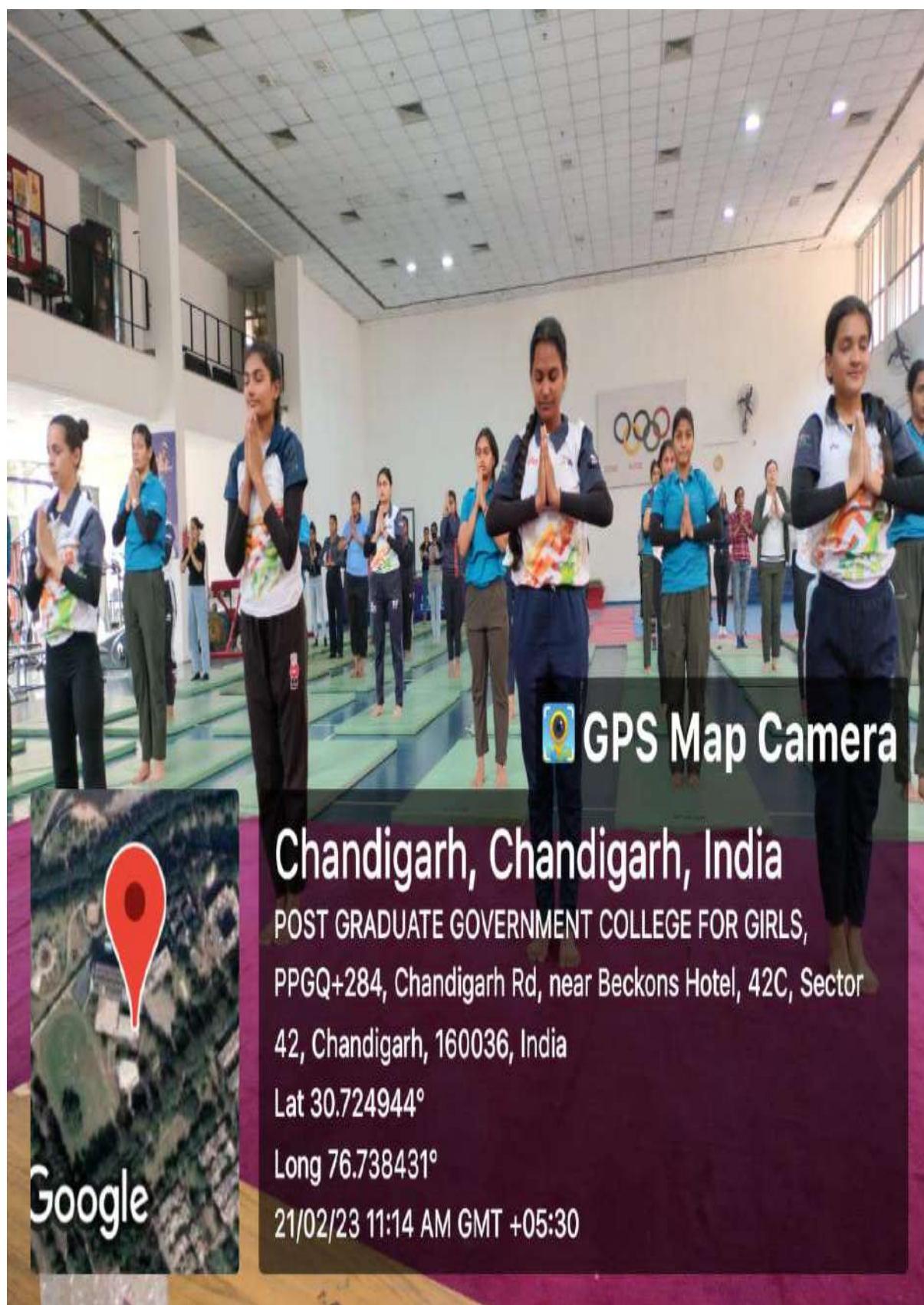
