The Scholarship Division, Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, New Delhi has intimated that the Competent Authority has decided to open the Portal (for both Fresh and Renewal Applications) as per the following timelines:-

For Pre-Matric Scholarship Schemes:-

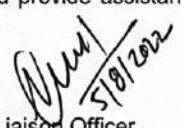
Opening of Portal	20 th July, 2022
Last date for application submission	30 th September, 2022
Last date for INO level verification	16 th October, 2022
Last date for second level verification	31 st October, 2022

For Post-Matric/Top-class scholarship schemes:-

Opening of Portal	20 th July, 2022
Last date for application submission	31 st October, 2022
Last date for INO level verification	15 th November, 2022
Last date for second level verification	30 th November, 2022

Further, the following points/instructions/guidelines are also suggested to the Institute Nodal Officer for smooth functioning of scholarship work:-

1. Institute Nodal Officer instructs their eligible students that "All renewal applicants/students, who have got scholarship during 2021-22, shall apply by giving their existing Application ID".
2. All Universities/Institutes/Colleges/Schools, having valid AISHE/UDISE/NCVT/SCVT codes, located in the UT, Chandigarh should be advised to register themselves on National Scholarship Portal and also update courses details at the earliest so that their students can apply timely.
3. Aadhar based demographic authentication of Institutes are compulsory. Therefore, you are requested to complete your Aadhar based demographic authentication at the earliest, if not already done.
4. All INOs are suggested to verify the applications of the students on NSP using their Institute's User ID and Password, well in time.
5. All INOs are advised to submit KYC registration form to this office, if not done previous session.
6. It has been observed that after the last date(s) of verification during the previous session, large number of fresh as well as Renewal applications are left pending for verification at INOs level. Therefore, all INOs are advised to look into this issue and ensure that no application remains unverified after the last date(s) of verification during 2022-23.
7. All verification authorities (INO/DNO/SNO) can mark an application fake if he/she is satisfied that the applicant is not a bonafide student. In other circumstances, in case of non-fulfillment of eligibility criteria or inconsistency of records, the verifying authority may either reject the application or mark it defective and give the applicant another opportunity to correct their records.
8. Technical issue, if any arise during the process of online submission, generation of merit lists and payment lots may be resolved immediately in consultation with the NIC HQ, State NICs or contact O/o Director Higher Education, Chandigarh.
9. The applicant can see the major conditions of eligibility as well as time-lines and FAQs with regards to various activities relating to submission of application form on the NSP homepage of the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in.
10. The eligible candidates can apply through online on the website of National Scholarship Portal of Govt. of India under URL www.scholarships.gov.in. Applicant will take printouts of the duly filled application forms and to the submit the same alongwith all supporting documents to the Insitute Nodal Officer.
11. To increase Gross Enrolment Ratio under the said scheme, all Institutes are advised that the guidelines/instruction of the scheme will be displayed on their Notice Board and also ask to the class teacher to find out the poorest/eligible SC students and provide assistance to fill the scholarship application form on National Scholarship Portal.
