

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA/ GUIDELINES TO CONTEST
THE STUDENTS' COUNCIL ELECTION (2023-24)

1. Age of the Candidates: U.G. Class = 17-22 yrs.
P.G. Class = 24-25 yrs.
(Note: The above mentioned age as on 1st September, 2023).
2. Attendance: 75% in all the offered subjects are mandatory.
3. No Re-appear or Backlog case in the previous Academic years.
4. Only *One* (1) chance to contest the election of "*Office Bearer*" and *Two* (2) chances for "*Class Representative*".
5. Also attach self-attested copies of all the '*Mark-Sheets*' of previous Semesters (declared results by P.U., Chd.) and also your 10th Class Mark-Sheet or Birth Certificate as '*Date of Birth*' proof.
6. Incomplete Nomination Forms submitted are out-rightly rejected.
7. The candidate must have read Panjab University Guidelines for Students' Council Election (2023-24), available on the College Website.
8. The candidate should not be convicted in any criminal offence or misdemeanor. She has not been subjected to any disciplinary action by College Authorities in the past.

Notice For Candidates

1. The campaigning of the Students' Council Elections ends on 4th September, 2023 (by 4:00 pm). No group or mass campaigning in any form is allowed thereafter.
2. All activities which are considered to be "*CORRUPT PRACTICES*" and offences, such as bribing of voters, intimidation of voters, impersonation of voters, canvassing or the use of propaganda within 100 meters of polling stations, holding public meetings during the period of 24-hours ending with the hour fixed for the close of poll and the transport and conveyance of voters to and from the polling station.
3. The maximum permitted expenditure per candidate shall be ₹5000/-. Each candidate shall within 2 weeks of the declaration of the results, submit a complete and certified account (to be certified by the candidate itself) to the college authorities in Election Office.
4. The election of the candidate will be nullified in the event of any non-compliance or in the event of any excessive expenditure.
