INTRODUCTION

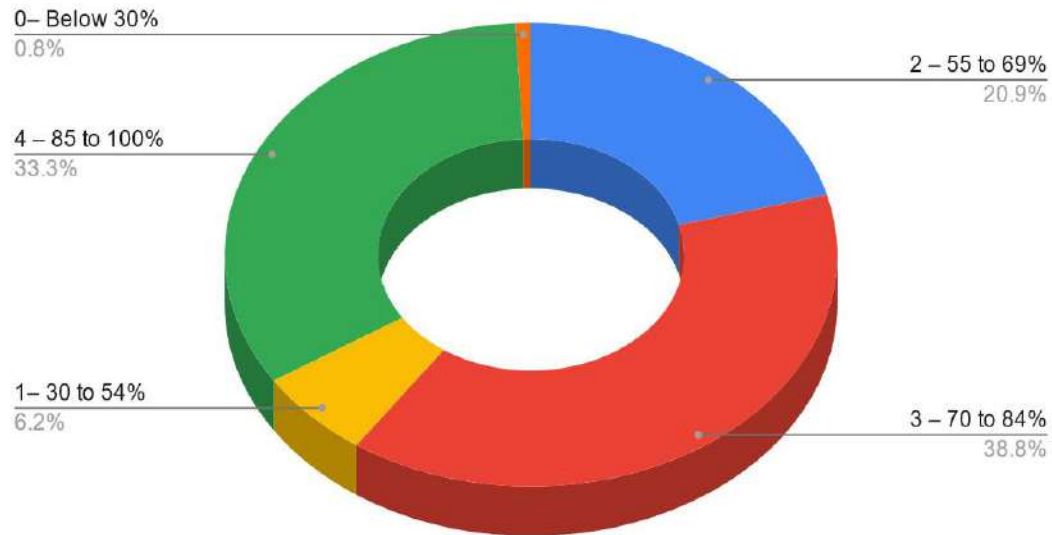

Their feedback considerably showcases the actual quality of teaching-learning process enabling identification of the strengths of teaching as well as the possible improvements.

Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) that results from evaluation of students' experience with the facilities and support they received in the college is very important. It is a valid and reliable tool to understand the key areas for future developments. Thus, it allows understanding the resources for areas that require greater attention. Thus, it is a direct and useful indicator of the effectiveness of teaching-learning in the institution. The college always encourages the students to take active participation in SSS.

With this purpose, a Students Satisfaction survey was conducted regarding Teaching – Learning and Evaluation, infrastructure, facilities in college and hostel etc which will help to upgrade the quality of higher education. The college circulated the questionnaire to all admitted students for the session 2022-23 i.e. 3029 students. Out of these, 1851 students i.e. 61.11% of the total strength responded with their feedback and gave their suggestions regarding teaching learning process, infrastructure and other parameters for the college and hostel. Their responses regarding the same were analysed and are listed in the report. The necessary actions were taken by the college. The questionnaire is attached as annexure to this report.

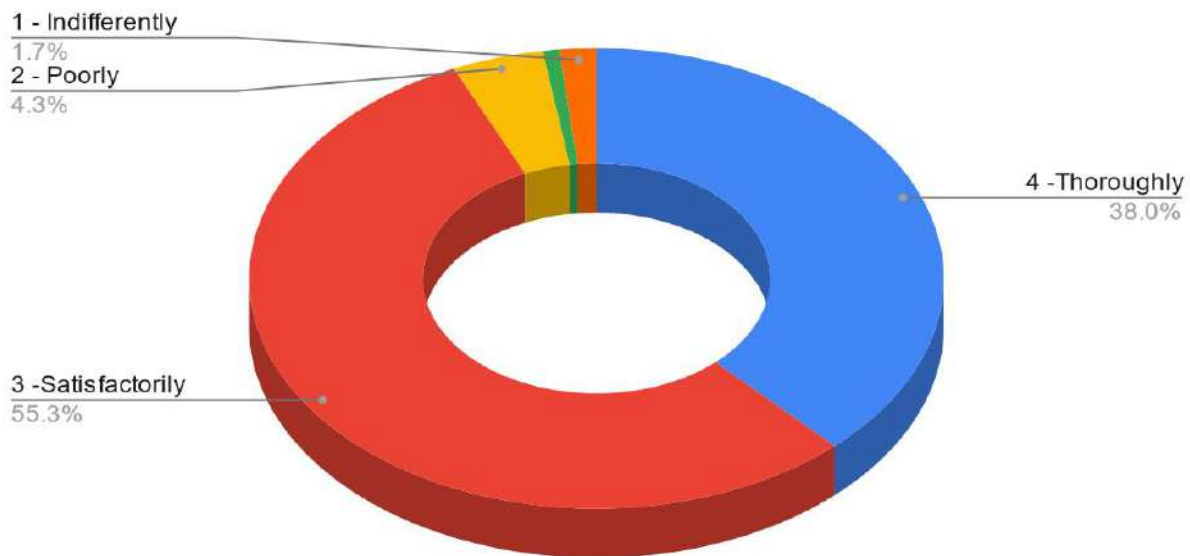
1. How much of the Syllabus has been covered during the session

As shown in the chart, most of the students are agreed that the syllabus has been covered during the session on time.

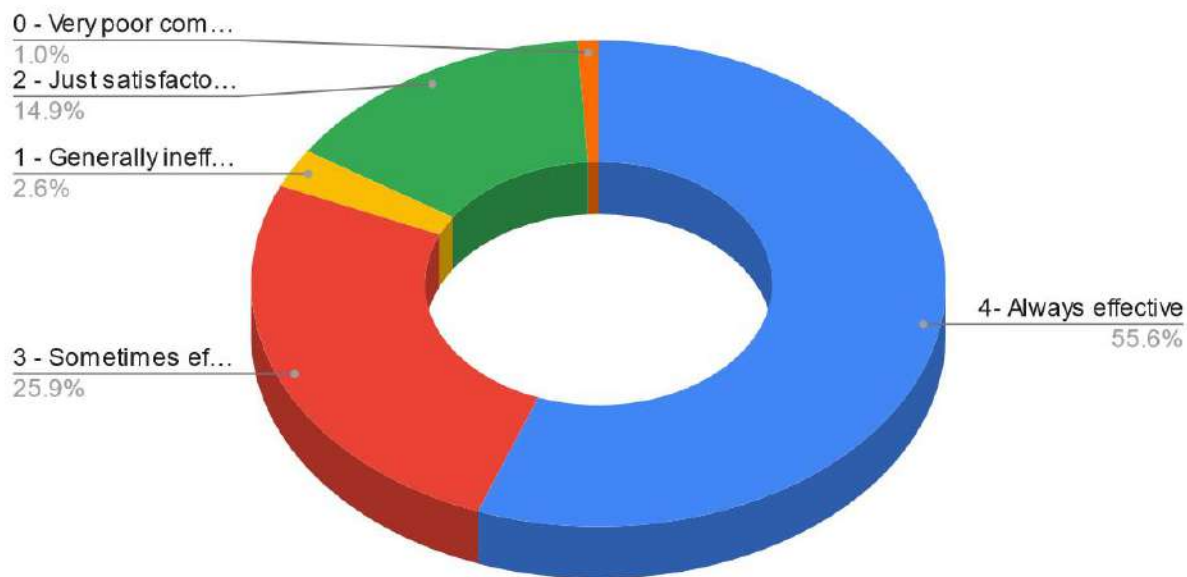
2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?

Chart shows, majority of the students are agreed that teachers are well prepared about the topics which they teach/discuss in the class with PPT's & advance teaching tools.

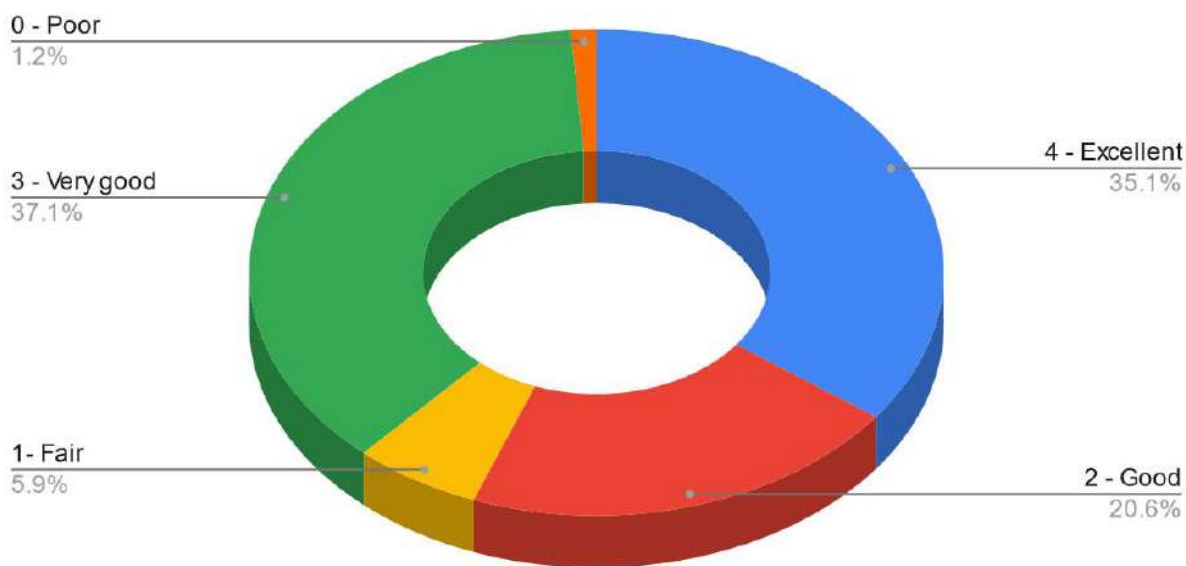
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?

As per data, 1030 Student's agreed that teacher's communicate with the them are always effective with clear concepts.

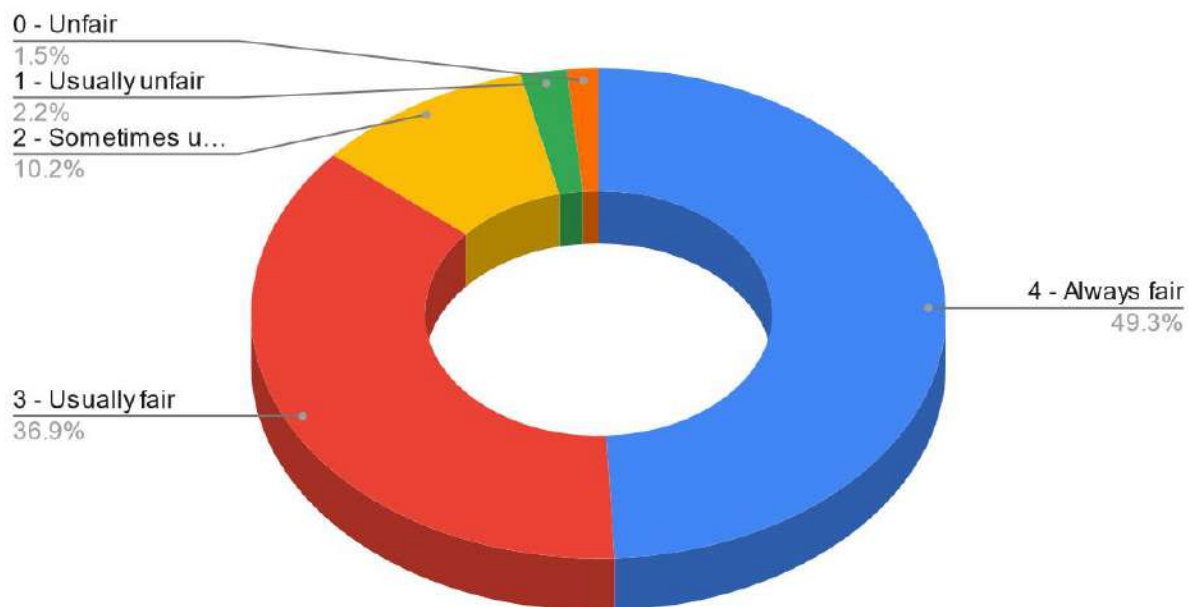
4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be describe as

Many of the student's shows teacher's approach is best to teach. Teacher's guide their student's in every perspective such as personality development , soft skills & life skills etc.

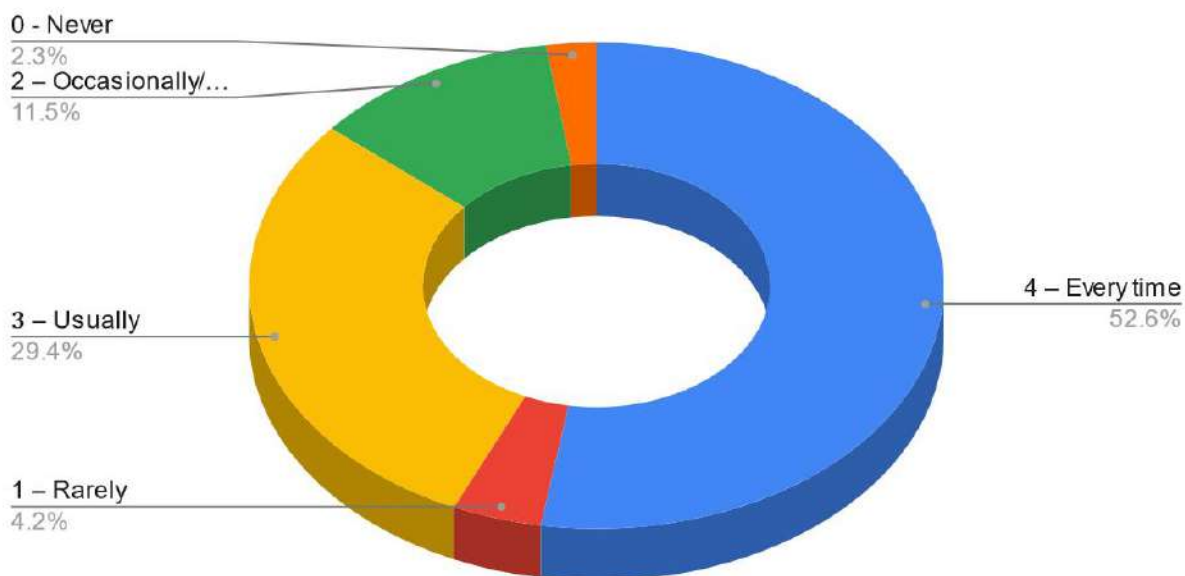
5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.

6. Was your performance in assignments/mid semester test discussed with you?

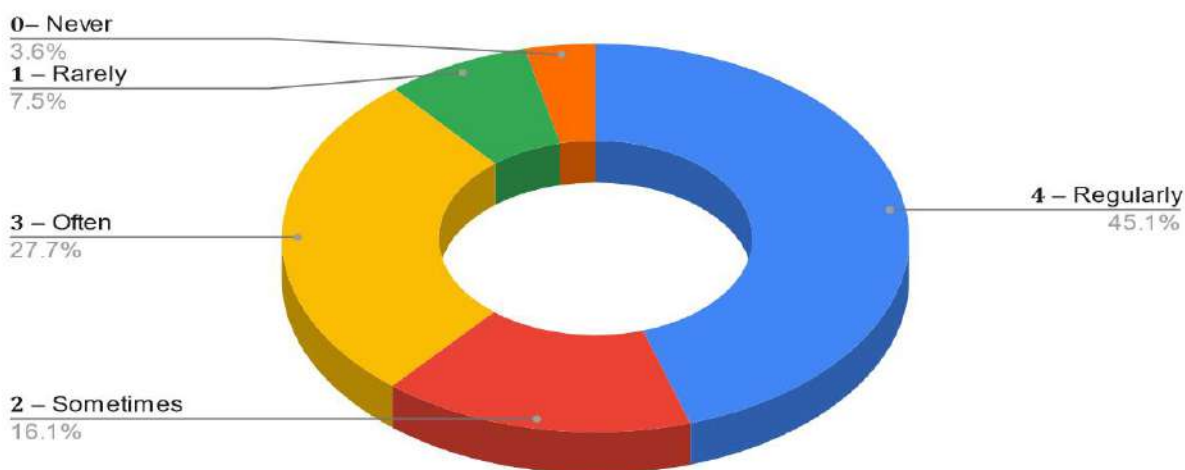

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, and field visit opportunities for students.

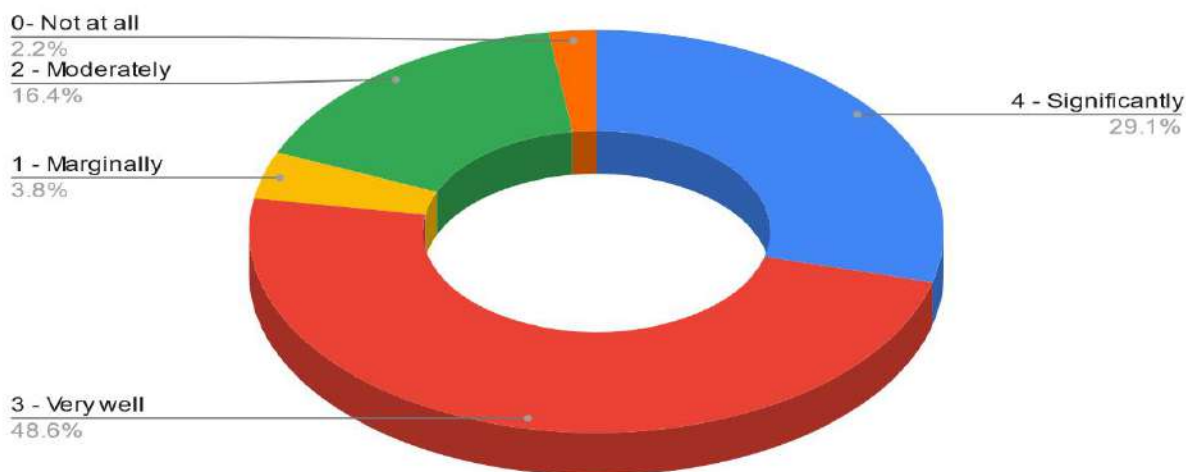

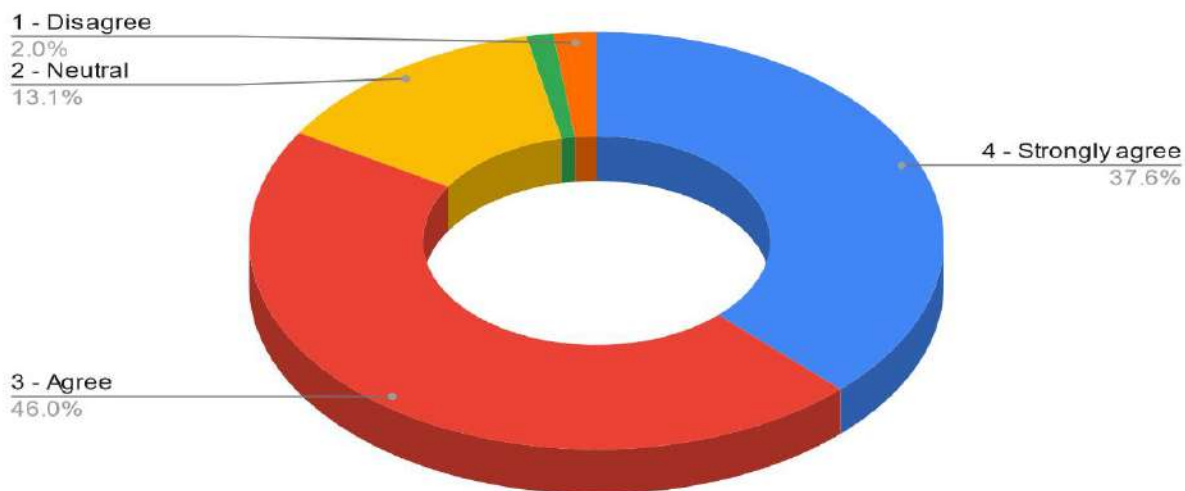
8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institute facilitate you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

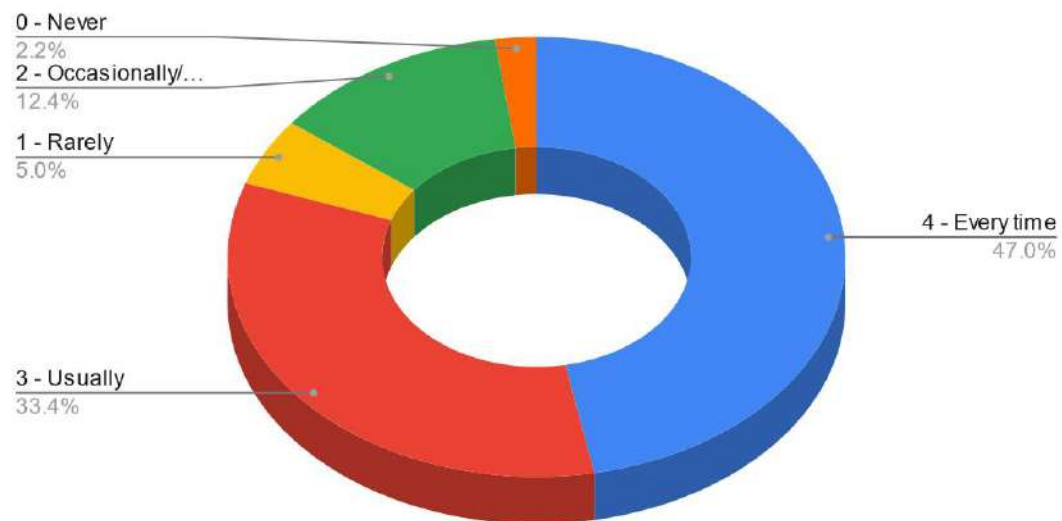
9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

Most of the student's agreed, college always provide many opportunities to learn & growth in the field of personality, academic, emotional, psychological & overall performance of the students.

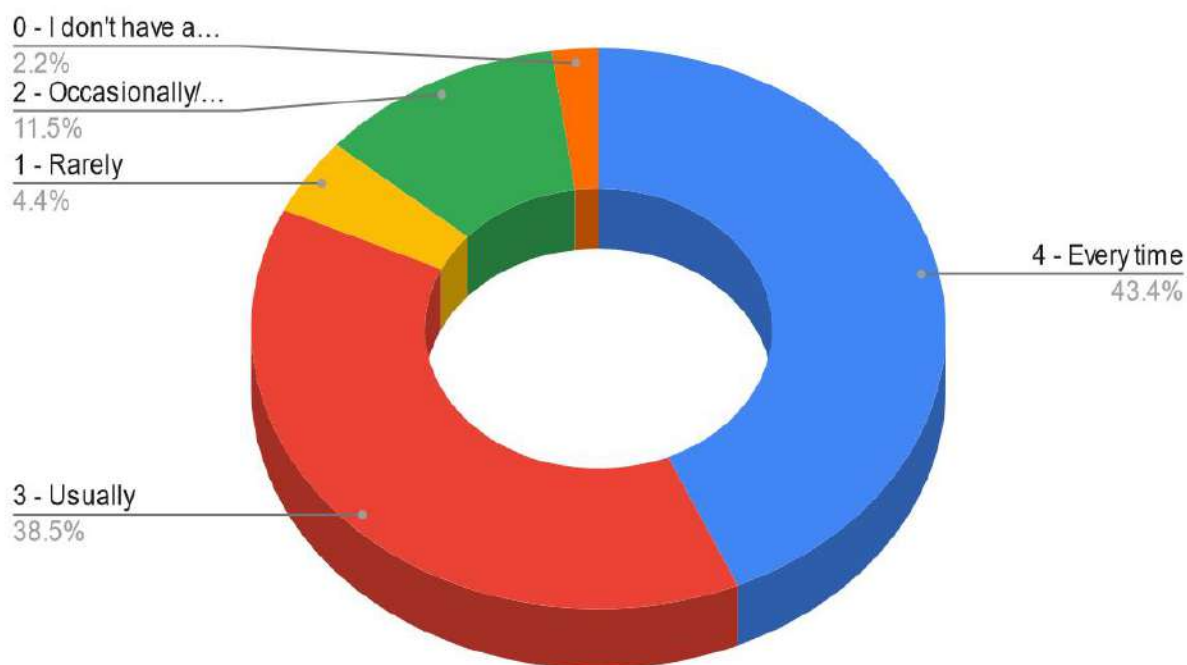
10. Teacher informs you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes.

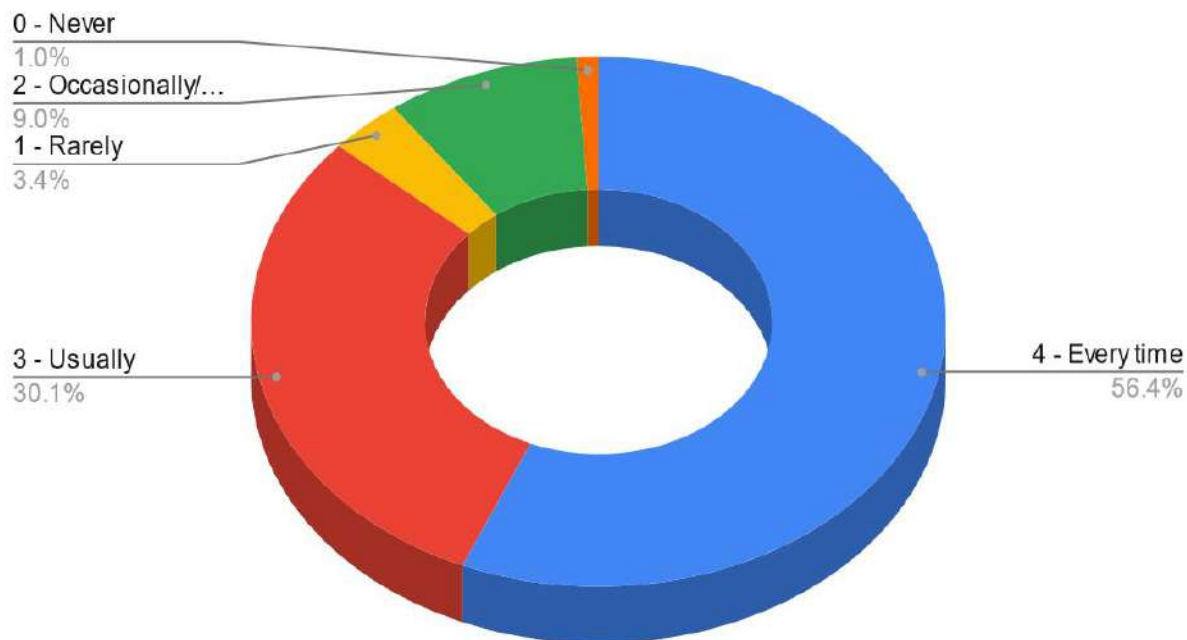
11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.

As student's responded positively about the follow-up by teacher's on regular basis of any task has assigned by them. They ask student's regarding the progress of task & guide them accordingly.

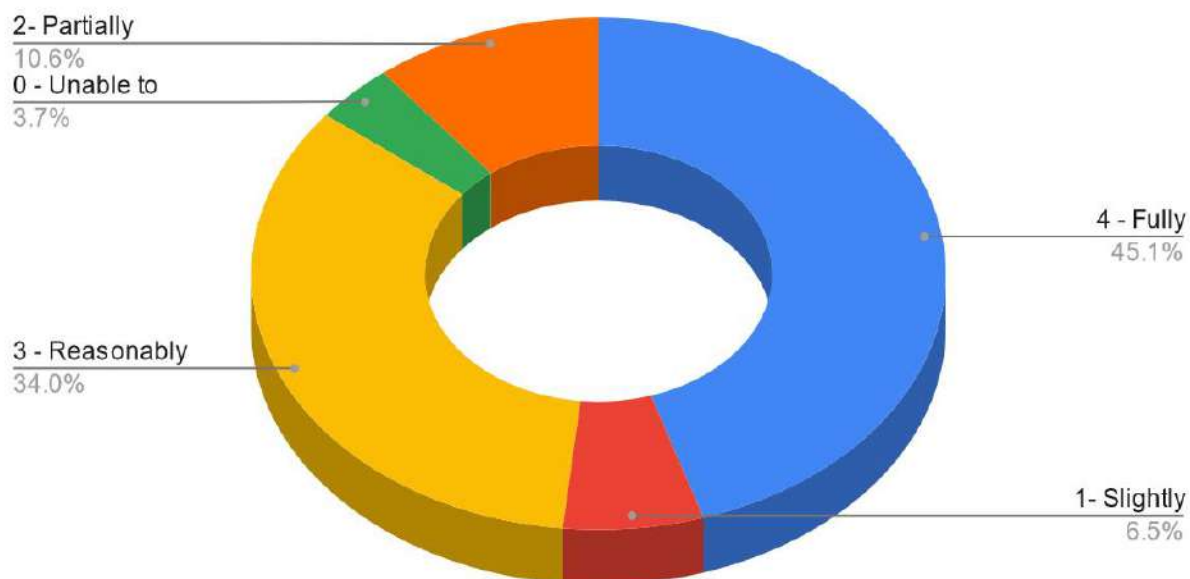
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

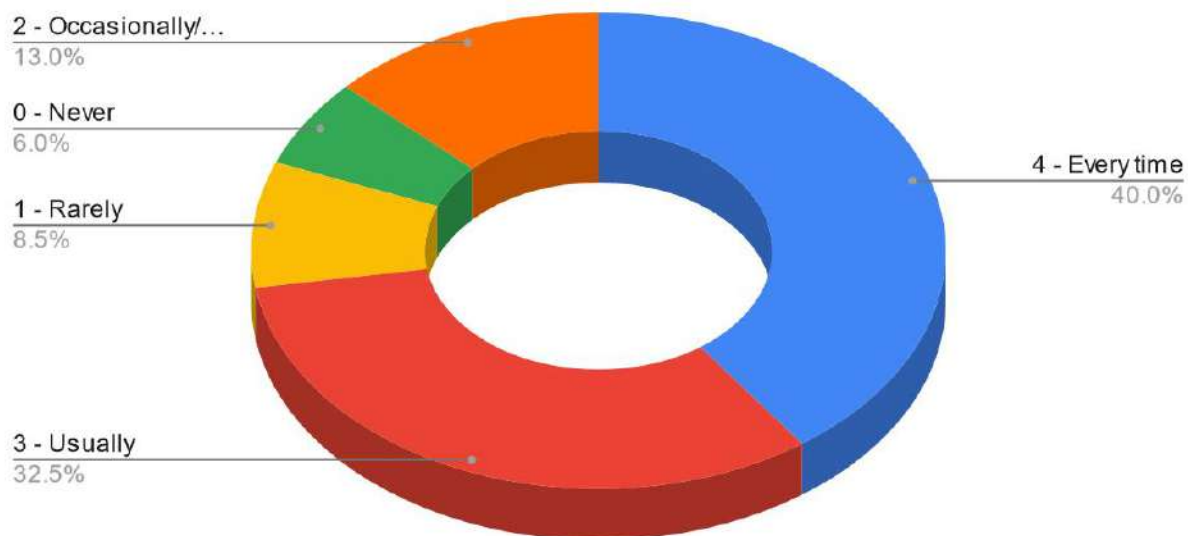

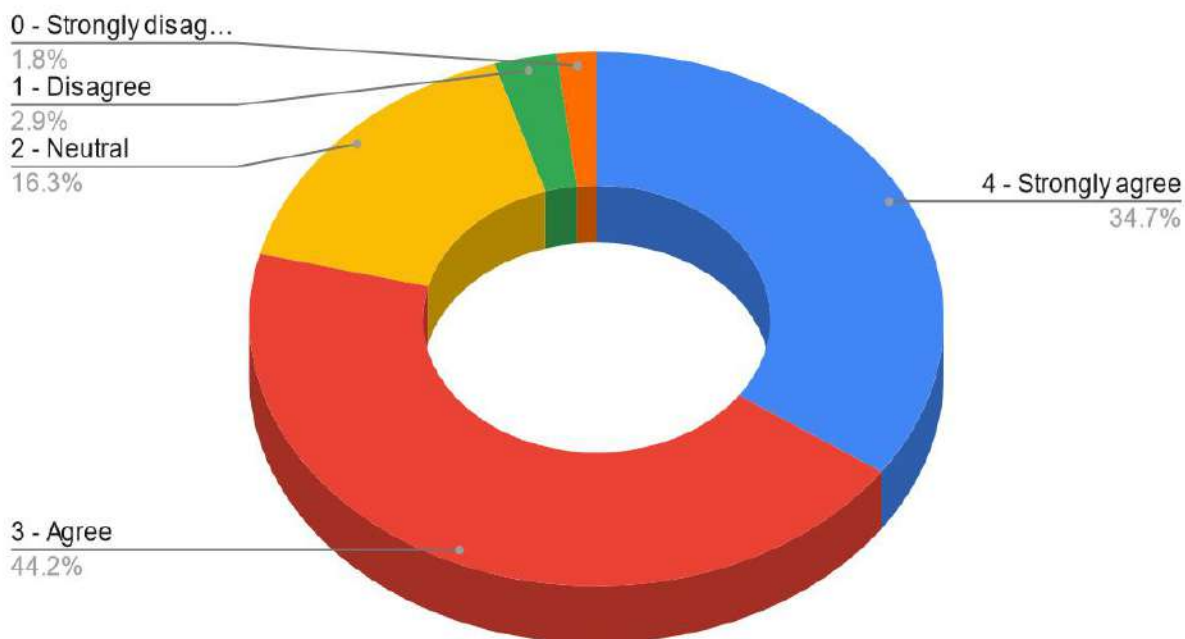

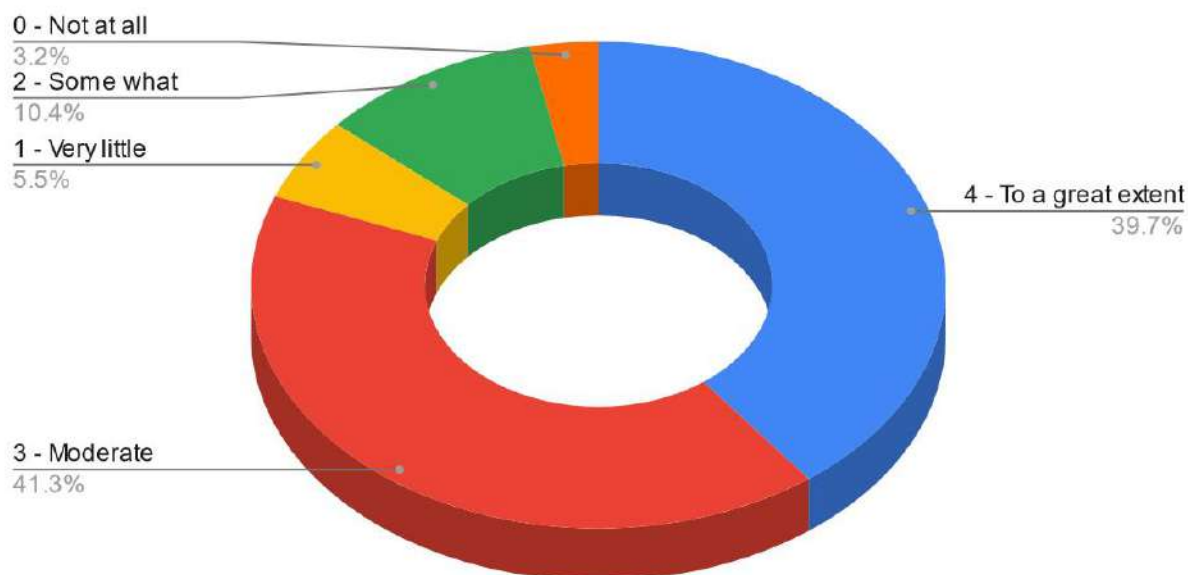

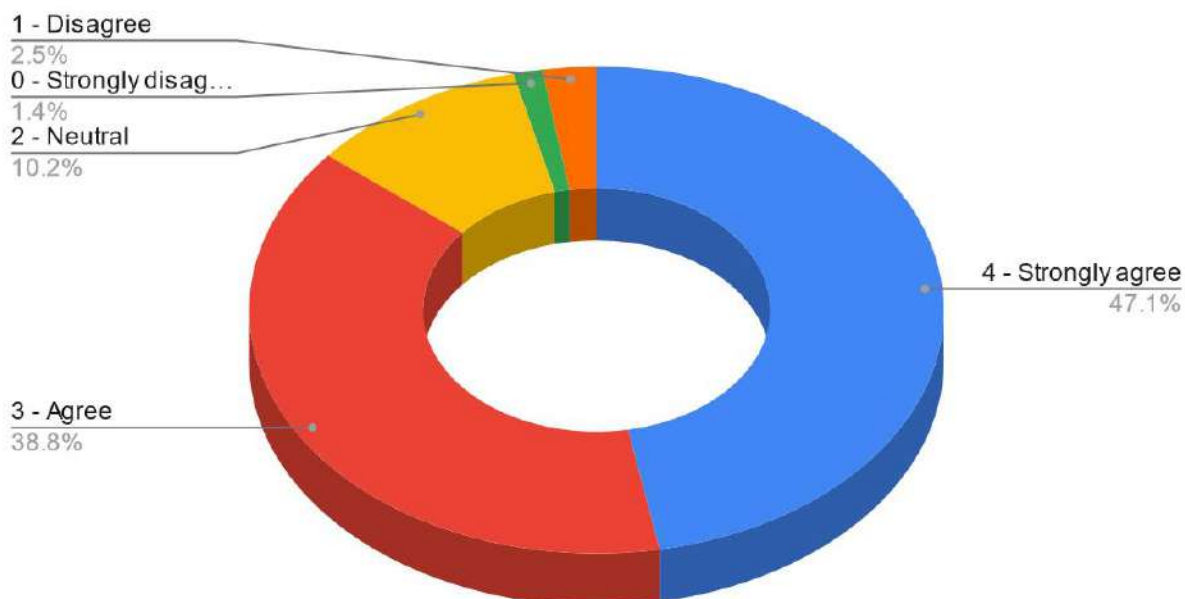

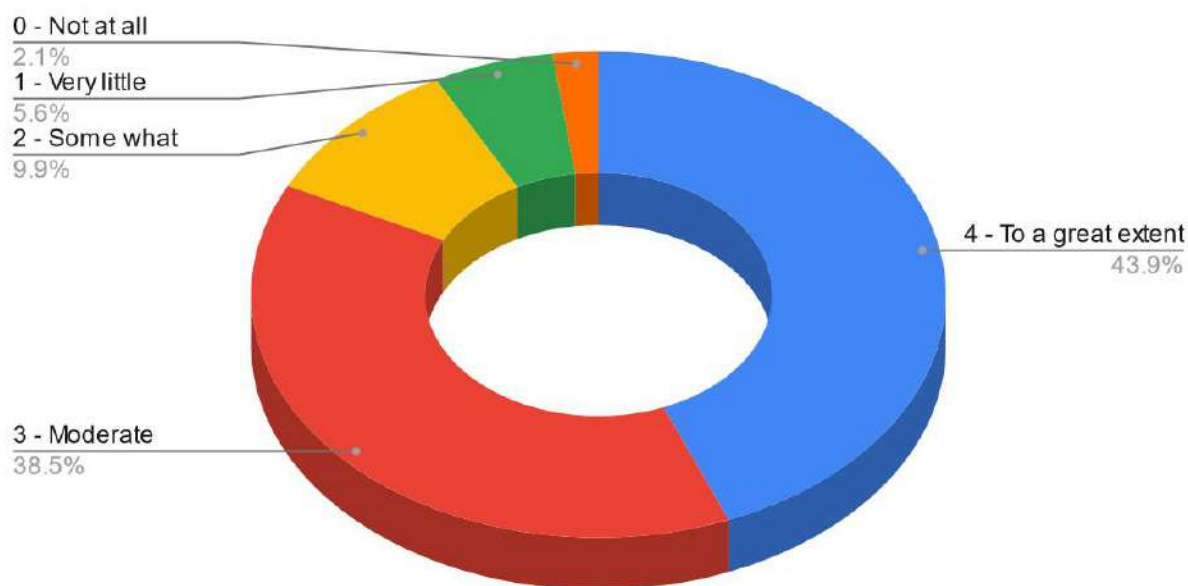

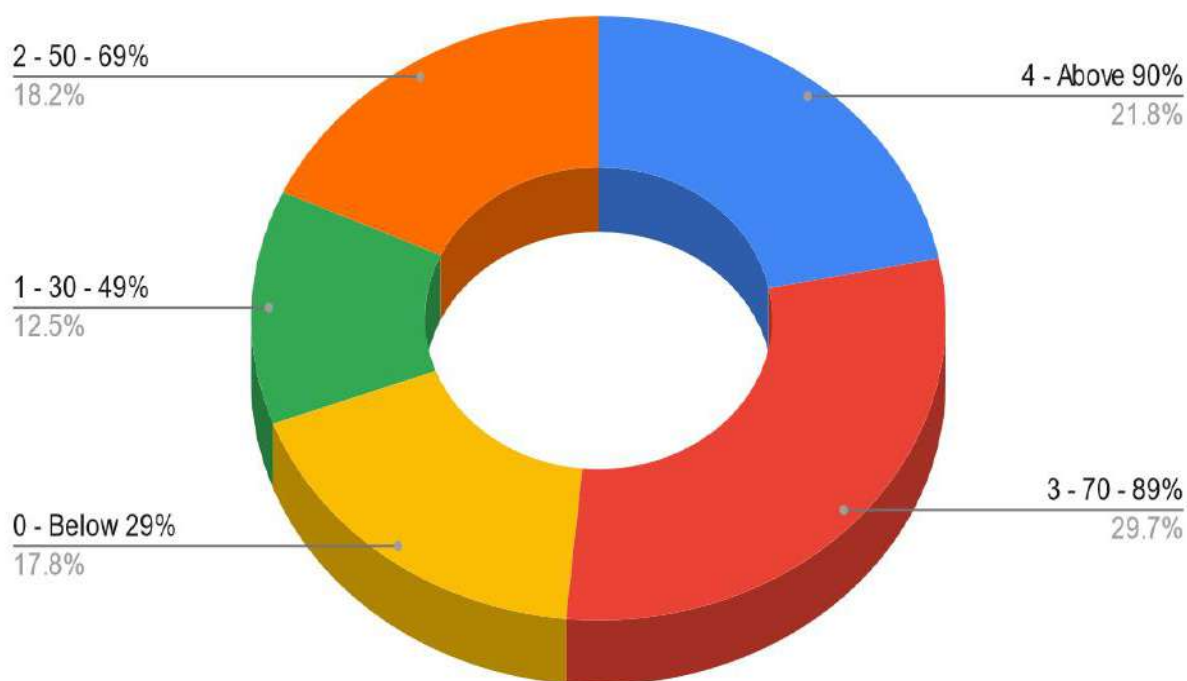
18. Efforts are made by the institute/teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.

Majority of the student's agreed, curricular aspects such as personality development, soft skills, life skills etc.has had a positive impact on their employability.

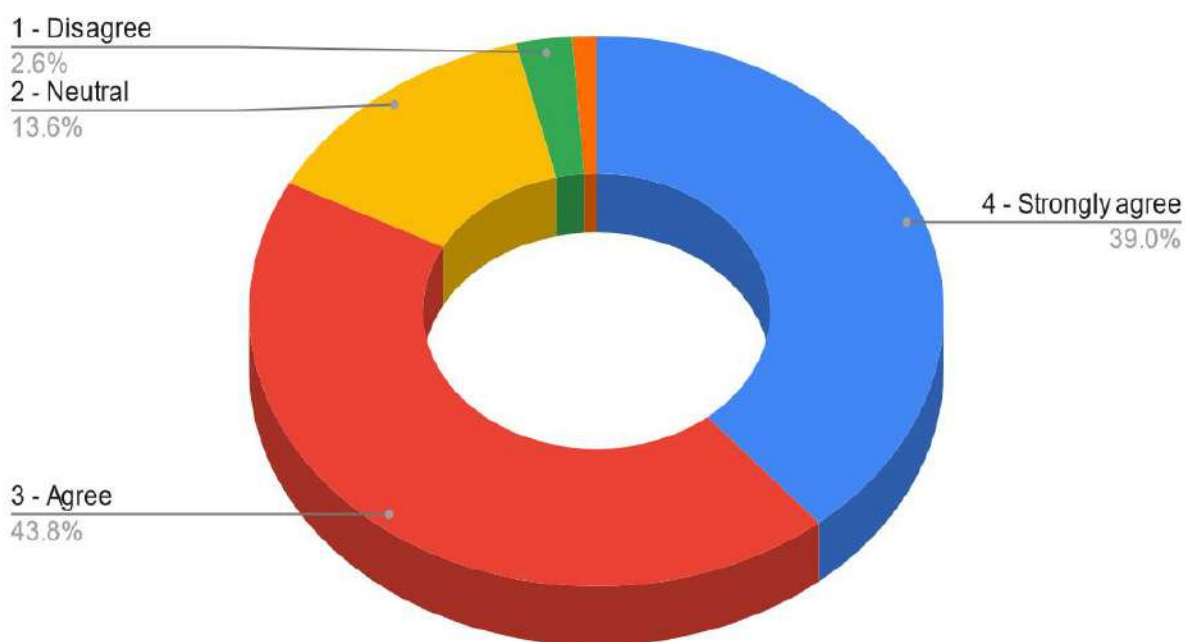

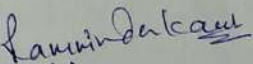
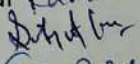
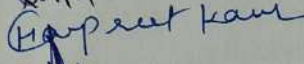
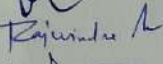
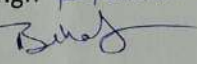
STEPS TAKEN ON THE BASIS OF STUDENTS' OBSERVATIONS REGARDING TEACHING – LEARNING

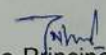
- From the students feedback it is analysed that students wish to experience more skill based learning. At college level, the training and placement cell keeps on arranging programs like workshops, seminars, training programs to enhance the employability skills among students. As far as course curriculum is concerned, it is designed by Panjab University. Our faculty tries to emphasize need of industry inclined curriculum for various courses and programs.
- Faculty members are encouraged to make use of ICT tools during class hours.
- The college hosts guest lectures, workshops, intra-departmental and inter-college fests, internships, and quizzes to enhance student-centered learning. Students are expected to take part in a variety of activities.
- Library already has books as prescribed by Panjab University in English, Hindi and Punjabi.
- Library staff has made efforts to give orientation to students.
- Signage of Library is also improved.
- Students are given training to use Library OPAC.
- Notebooks are allowed in magazine section, inside the stack areas they are not allowed for security reasons.
- A proposal has been recently sent for upgradation of Library.
- College library created and maintained a blog where students can access online books, journals, previous question papers and other resources easily through links provided in the user friendly blog.
- Internet bandwidth has been increased from 10mbps to 150 mbps in the college for students use.
- The college has thirty-nine laboratories in various subjects. These labs are equipped with all relevant items as per University norms. The college also has a dedicated research lab for life sciences.

STEPS TAKEN ON THE BASIS OF STUDENTS' OBSERVATIONS REGARDING HOSTEL & CANTEEN

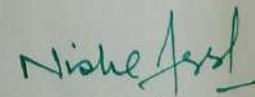
- College has a medical room in the college for convenience of the students and staff.

- Hostel Wi-Fi facilities for students have been improved considerably. 24X7 internet facility has been made available for the hostel students.
- Hostel welfare committee keeps frequent checks on quality of food, infrastructure maintenance and to resolve every issue of the hostel.
- Sanitary Napkins can be purchased from Hostel Nurse also at the rate Rs.5 per piece.
