Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, a premier multi-faculty institution of Higher Education in the City Beautiful, Chandigarh, was established in 1982. Notably, the library issues identity cards to students and offers character certificates to graduates, along with **free books and stationery for SC/ST students**. Moreover, initiatives like the "Leave a Book - Take a Book" corner and paper donation drive promote community engagement and sustainability. The library's infrastructure, including RFID systems, internet terminals, and printers, ensures efficient operations.

The Wisdom Tree Library Club encourages a culture of reading through various activities and events. Regular updates on the library's blog and Face book page keep students informed about its services and events, fostering a dynamic and inclusive learning environment.
