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### ***COLLEGE PROFILE***

Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, a premier multi-faculty institution of Higher Education in the City Beautiful, Chandigarh, was established in 1982. Spread over a spacious campus of nearly 18 acres in the southern part of Chandigarh, the college has emerged as an all-encompassing institute. It imparts education to about 3400 students in the streams of Commerce, Humanities, Science and Computer Applications.

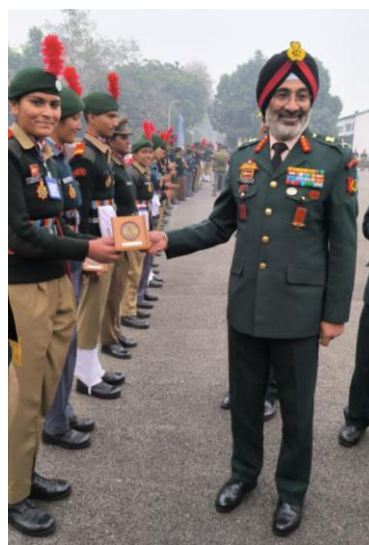

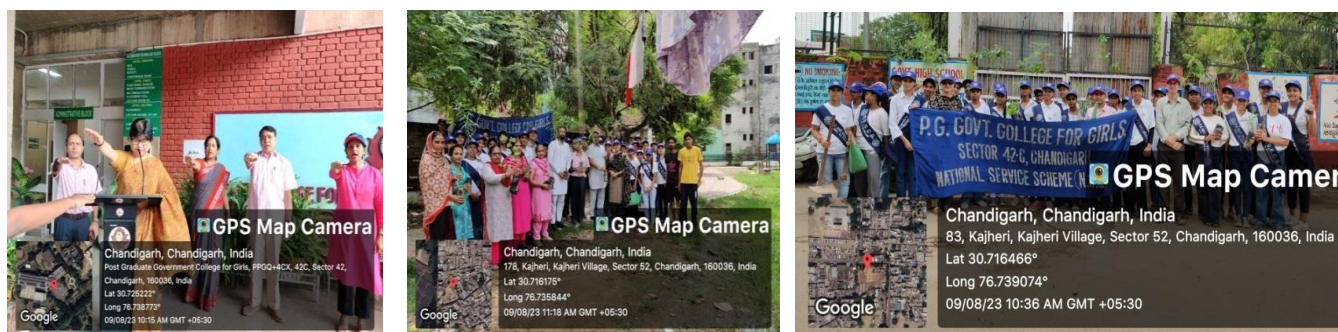






## LIBRARY






The college boasts a state-of-the-art library equipped with modern amenities to cater to the academic needs of its students. With a daily footfall of 400-450 students, the library serves as a hub for reading, research, and internet browsing. Its extensive collection of **43,000 printed books** spans various disciplines, complemented by subscriptions to **21 Journals, 55 Magazines, and 15 Newspapers**. Additionally, as a member of **NLIST-INFLIBNET and DELNET**, the library provides **access to over 6,000 Journals and 164,300 eBooks**. Services offered include circulation, reference assistance, information literacy training, and access to digital resources. Notably, the library issues identity cards to students and offers character certificates to graduates, along with **free books and stationery for SC/ST students**. Moreover, initiatives like the "Leave a Book - Take a Book" corner and paper donation drive promote community engagement and sustainability. The library's infrastructure, including RFID systems, internet terminals, and printers, ensures efficient operations.

**The Wisdom Tree Library Club** encourages a culture of reading through various activities and events. Regular updates on the library's blog and Face book page keep students informed about its services and events, fostering a dynamic and inclusive learning environment.
