Session On Road Safety Rules organized by Road Safety Society of PGGCG-42, Chandigarh

The Principal also laid emphasis on the dire need to educated the youth in midst of increasing accidents and negligence. Convener of the Road Safety Society Dr. Shefali Malhotra alongwith others member Dr. Rashmi Kohli and Dr. Vikas highlighted that safety is not just a responsibility it is a necessity for a civilized and conscientious society. An important takeaway from the session was the emphasis on shared responsibility. The session concluded with a Q&A segment, where participants could voice their concerns and ask questions.
