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Student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem solving methodologies used for enhancing learning experiences

Teachers use various didactic teaching methods depending on the needs of the students, their personal preferences and other factors. From designing lesson plans and assigning coursework to setting specific learning objectives, our teaching process characterizes a student centric approach. We realize that it is important for the students to ‘learn by doing’ and participate wholly in the learning process. The didactic methods we employ ensure that the students stay actively involved.

1. Educational Tours/ Field Visits

- On 18th September 2016, 45 students of Srishti Society were taken to Shanti Kunj, Sector-16, Chandigarh for Tree Walk under the guidance of **Dr. H. S. Dhillon, Senior Horticulturist**, and **Rajnish Watts, Director and Writers of the book *Trees Of Chandigarh***, who is also the founder of Chandigarh Tree Lovers’ Group. They raised awareness amongst students regarding tree behavior and flora of Chandigarh. The event also celebrated the Ozone Protection Day.
- Each academic year, the students of BSc and MSc are taken to the following places as part of their curriculum so that they can learn by experience. The only years that the activities could not take place were 2020-21 due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

i. Visit to SAIF, CIL and UCIM Panjab University, Chandigarh

Sophisticated Analytical Instrumentation Facility, formerly known as RSIC, USIC and CIL work in unison in the service of research and impart practical training to the students through workshops.

ii. Visit to the Zoology Department, Panjab University, Chandigarh

One of the oldest and well-established departments in North-India, it has completed 140 years of teaching and research. M.Sc. students visit the department for demonstration of Scanning Electron Microscope & Transmission Electron Microscope.

iii. Visit to nearby Water Treatment Plant

Students of M.Sc.-I & II are taken to the Plant to see the process of Water treatment and the various phases of Primary, Secondary and Tertiary treatments.

iv. Visit to Chhatbir Zoo, a zoological park situated in Zirakpur, Punjab

The students observe the behaviour of birds, terrestrial animals, aquatic animals, reptiles and nocturnal animals and get a better understanding of their controlled habitats.

v. Visit to Government Museum & Art Gallery, Sector-10, Chandigarh

Science students learn about the evolutionary history of man at the Museum of Evolution of Life where they learn through the colossal paintings on the wall about the evolution of man from a single-cell organism. The Museum Complex also houses the National History Museum specifically dedicated to flora and fauna that existed in early times and still exist. The students also explore the dioramas of dinosaurs and early humans along with other geology specimens.

vi. Visit to CSIR-CSIO Laboratory

The students of Science are taken every year to visit the Central Scientific Instruments Organisation, a national laboratory dedicated to research, design and development of scientific, and industrial instruments.

- On 28th October 2017, the students of Srishti Society were taken on a field trip to **Sarangpur Botanical Garden, Mullanpur, Punjab**.
- On 11th November 2017 the students of MSc. I were taken to **Sukhna Lake, Chandigarh to watch migratory birds** under the guidance of Dr. Dalip Kumar and Dr. Divya Sharma. A field lecture by Mr. Kulbhushan Kanwar was also organized. Another field trip to the Sukhna lake was organized on 24th November 2018 under the guidance of Dr. Neelam K. Sharma where a field lecture was given by Sh. Navtej Singh.
- On 4th October 2019, during Wildlife Week, students of Srishti Society were taken to visit Sukhna Wildlife Sanctuaries and City Forest.
- On 24th February 2018, a visit to the **Apiary in Siswan Khurd, Chandigarh** was organized for B. Sc. III students under the guidance of Dr. Neelima Talwar where they studied the insect fauna and habitat of this region.




8. Internships/ On Job Training
