

## **Report on Celebration of Sardar@150 (28th Oct - 31st Oct 2025)**

Under the able guidance of Principal Prof. Anita Kaushal, PGGCG 42 Chandigarh organised various activities as part of pre-event category of Sardar@150.

A Drug De-addiction Pledge-taking Ceremony and Awareness Rally were organised on 28th October 2025 to foster a strong commitment to a drug-free society and combat substance abuse within the community.
