## Library, PGGCG-42, Chandigarh

The **fully air-conditioned, RFID-enabled library** at **Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector-42, Chandigarh**, is a **modern knowledge hub** designed to cater to the academic and research needs of students and faculty. With a capacity to accommodate **400–450 users daily**, it provides a **spacious, comfortable, and technology-driven environment** that enhances learning and intellectual growth.

The library operates with **LSease software**, ensuring seamless circulation, efficient cataloging, and real-time access to bibliographic records. The **RFID-based self-service system** allows users to issue, return, and renew books independently, improving efficiency and minimizing waiting time. The library houses a **diverse and extensive collection** of resources, including textbooks, reference books, journals, dissertations, rare books, newspapers, old question papers, and multimedia content.

To facilitate **digital learning and research**, users have access to various **e-resources and databases** such as **INFLIBNET-NLIST, DELNET, ONOS, Vidwan, and IRINS**, offering thousands of e-books, e-journals, and research publications. The library also maintains a **Library Blog**, providing updates on **new acquisitions, syllabi, academic events, and digital learning materials** to keep students and faculty informed.

Beyond lending and reference services, the library actively promotes **intellectual engagement** through **book exhibitions, storytelling sessions, competitions, workshops, and training programs**. It also conducts **information literacy sessions** to equip users with essential research skills and effective use of e-resources.



