## COLLEGE PROFILE

Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, a premier multi-faculty institution of Higher Education in the City Beautiful, Chandigarh, was established in 1982. Spread over a spacious campus of nearly 18 acres in the southern part of Chandigarh, the college has emerged as an all-encompassing institute. It imparts education in the streams of Commerce, Humanities, Science and Computer Applications.

Accredited 'A' by NAAC, Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector 42, has carved a niche for itself in the northern region because of its infrastructure, multi-talented faculty and array of courses offered.

The college is embellished with well-maintained gardens, vast playgrounds, gymnasium, 2 hostels and a day care center. The college also boasts of a wi-fi enabled campus, 150 mbps lease line, and an exclusive Information Technology Block with cutting edge facilities.

## LIBRARY


The fully air-conditioned, RFID-enabled library at Post Graduate Government College for Girls, Sector-42, Chandigarh, is a modern knowledge hub designed to cater to the academic and research needs of students and faculty. The RFID-based self-service system allows users to issue, return, and renew books independently, improving efficiency and minimizing waiting time. The library houses a diverse and extensive collection of resources, including textbooks, reference books, journals, dissertations, rare books, newspapers, old question papers, and multimedia content.




To facilitate digital learning and research, users have access to various e-resources and databases such as INFLIBNET-NLIST, DELNET, ONOS, Vidwan, and IRINS, offering thousands of e-books, e-journals, and research publications. The library also maintains a Library Blog, providing updates on new acquisitions, syllabi, academic events, and digital learning materials to keep students and faculty informed.

Beyond lending and reference services, the library actively promotes intellectual engagement through book exhibitions, competitions, workshops, and training programs. It also conducts information literacy sessions to equip users with essential research skills and effective use of e-resources.

The RFID-enabled security system ensures the safety of library materials, while Computerized services, OPAC (Online Public Access Catalog), and Wi-Fi connectivity make resource discovery and retrieval effortless. The library is committed to fostering a conducive learning environment, encouraging students and faculty to explore, innovate, and excel in their academic pursuit.
